Registration: Enrollment is limited to 20 students, who are admitted on a first-come, first-served basis. The \$200 **commuter registration** fee includes all program costs. Registration forms, with payment information, can be completed online at wiu.edu/summeryouth, mailed to Study Abroad and Outreach, Horrabin Hall 8, Western Illinois University, 1 University Circle, Macomb, IL 61455, or faxed to (309) 298-2226. Checks should be made payable to Western Illinois University.

Pricing and Payment Assistance : Register before March 15, 2018 and receive a 10 percent early bird discount on the \$200 **commuter** registration cost. For payment plans and scholarships contact our office. We also will offer an **additional 10 percent discount** to families who send more than one child to a camp or enroll one child for multiple camps. Parents who wish to use a payment plan may send a \$100 deposit at the time of registration. Full payment is due 30 days before the start of the program.

Refund Policy: WIU reserves the right to withdraw a program because of unforeseen circumstances or insufficient enrollment. If a program is withdrawn,

participants will be notified and fees will be refunded. A \$50 fee will be charged to participants who cancel after Monday, May 14, 2018. **No refunds will be made on or after Monday, May 28, 2018**
