GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION: Enrollment is limited to 50 students per session, who are admitted on a first-come, first-served basis. The registration fees of \$435 for Session 1 (Commuter) and \$525 for Session 2 (Residential) include all program costs. Registration forms, with payment information, can be completed online at wiu.edu/summeryouth, mailed to Study Abroad & Outreach, Horrabin Hall 8, Western Illinois University, 1 University Circle, Macomb, IL 61455, or faxed to (309) 298-2226. Checks should be made payable to Western Illinois University.

Pricing and Payment Assistance Plan: Register before March 15, 2018, and receive a 10 percent early bird discount off the \$435 commuter and \$525 residential registration cost. Payment plan and scholarship information are available by contacting our office. We also will offer an additional 10 percent discount to families who send more than one child to a camp or enroll one child for multiple camps. Parents who wish to use a payment plan may send a \$100 deposit at the time of registration. Full payment is due 30 days before the start of the program. A limited number of partial scholarships will be awarded.

Refund Policy: Western Illinois University reserves the right to withdraw a program because of unforeseen circumstances or insufficient enrollment. If a program is withdrawn, participants are notified and fees are refunded. A \$50 fee is charged to participants who

cancel after Monday, June 4, 2018. No refunds will be made on or after Monday, June 11, 2018.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Residential participants stay in the Corbin/Olson residence hall, on the campus of Western Illinois University. All activities are supervised by faculty and resident counselors to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience on the University campus.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Western Illinois University's summer art program is designed to stimulate and challenge students' creativity in an intensive week of art study. Under the guidance of WIU faculty, and local artists, students will expand their skills and explore new ideas. During their stay, they will also enjoy swimming, indoor/outdoor games and movies. Participants will work in a safe and enjoyable environment. Western's summer art program has a long record of success and introduces students to a university environment.

TOPICS WILL INCLUDE:

Drawing and Painting: Using various media, students will review the basics of two-dimensional design and explore concepts such as proportion, perspective, measuring, spontaneity and the character of a line.

Airbrush: This portion of the program will introduce basic-level techniques used to create a variety of effects for illustration.

Computer Art: Using interactive software, students will examine the artistic capabilities of the computer and learn how to create through this medium.

Three-Dimensional Expression: Participants use various approaches, such as carving, molding or assembling, to create their own unique 3D sculptures.

PARTICIPATION CRITERIA

Session One (June 18-22) is a commuter only program, intended for fourth, fifth and sixth graders. Session Two (July 22-27) is a residential program, intended for sixth, seventh and eighth graders. Parents and sixth graders should work together to determine which session they are most suitably placed based on skill-level. All students are admitted on a first-come, first-serve basis. Enrollment is limited to 50 students per session, so early registration is encouraged.
